Information on getting to the Gardens

The Hopkirk Room is located at the rear of main range of glasshouses and can be reached by taking the road that leads to the management offices. After going through the gate, turn left and then follow the road round and the Hopkirk Room can be found on the left after going through another gate.

There is very limited parking in the Gardens and this can become congested. Priority will be given to Blue Badge Holders or to those transporting equipment etc. There is no parking in front of the glasshouses. When entering the Gardens via the vehicle entrance in Queen Margaret Drive follow the signs for the Hopkirk Building and remember that pedestrians have priority at all times. The speed limit is 5mph and you must drive with your hazard lights on.

Please park outside the Gardens and spaces can be found in the surrounding area. If you use Queen Margaret Drive, this is now metered and charges apply Monday to Sunday. The best option is to continue along Great Western passing the Gardens on your right hand side and then turn right at the traffic lights into Kirklee Road. There are usually spaces in the streets around Kelvinside Academy and there is a pedestrian entrance to the Gardens in Ford Road.

If using public transport the No. 6 bus from the City Centre passes along Great Western Road, ask for the Botanic Gardens. Alternatively, use the subway to Hillhead on Byres Road, then an eight minute walk to the Botanic Gardens.
